The study funds of every registered and prospective student of the institution are the responsibility of the individual student.

The institution will not enter into funding agreements or negotiations for funding on behalf of prospective students.

AFDA helps registered students of the institution get onto possible funding lists of a few funders who prefer to work through the institution.

This is also subject to the availability of funders, as well as the current student meeting set criteria.

Please ensure to research accordingly and engage with the bursary provider directly on their application procedure, however feel free to ask us advice about bursary applications during your consultation or visit to one of our Open Days. It is advisable to have submitted your AFDA application, had your consultation with us and make use of your acceptance letter with your bursary application. We suggest applying for as many bursary providers as possible that you meet the criteria for, as well as considering provisional application for a study loan so you know whether this is an option for you.

WHERE TO START WITH STUDY LOANS

There are many financial institutions that offer student funding, including big banks and other financial service providers, such as Capitec (please see more information below), FNB, ABSA, Nedbank and Standard Bank. Every bank / institution has their specific criteria of what to apply with and will offer you a different interest rate. So shop around until you find the best deal that suits you. We recommend that once you have received your acceptance letter via email, you use it to apply for your Study Loan in the year **before** you enrol and start studying at AFDA.

MANDELA RHODES FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

ABOUT THE BURSARY PROGRAMME – FIELDS COVERED & COVERAGE VALUE

The Mandela Rhodes Scholarship programme, administered by the Mandela Rhodes Foundation, is named after 2 men – Nelson Mandela and Cecil Rhodes. The scholarship comprises of 2 parts – financial funding for postgraduate studies and a leadership development programme. The funding component is for **postgraduate studies (Honours and Masters Degrees)** in **ANY field** of study, at a South African tertiary institution. Students will receive full funding for a maximum duration of 1 year for Honours students, and a maximum duration of 2 years for Masters Students.

The scholarship provides coverage for the following expenses: registration fees, tuition fees, allowance for meals and accommodation, allowance for study materials, allowance for medical aid, personal allowance and an allowance for economy-class travel for international students (from their home to the institution at the start and end of their studies). The leadership development programme component aims to develop the leadership capacity in Africa, and is made up of 3 components (mentoring, 3 regional group pods and 3 residential workshops).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must satisfy the following minimum entry criteria before applying (please note that failure to satisfy all therequirements will lead to your application not being considered):

- Citizen of ANY African country
- Between 19 and 29 years old (and under 30 years old at the time you start your postgraduate studies)
- In possession of a first degree qualification OR currently completing your undergraduate degree and will complete before taking up postgraduate studies in January 2021
- Achieved a minimum average of 70% in degree studies
- Studying or intend on studying full time towards a postgraduate (Honours or Masters, NOT MBA) qualification
- Studying or intend on studying at a recognised South African tertiary institute
- Good academic record
- Will attend leadership development workshops
- Committed to the following principles – Education, Entrepreneurship, Leadership and Reconciliation
- Demonstrated leadership on campus or in your community

NATIONAL FILM & VIDEO FOUNDATION (NFVF)

National Bursaries - Application Criteria

- Student should be accepted and registered at an institution that offers formal tertiary qualifications.
- Should be able to demonstrate financial need, i.e. by submitting parent's payslips etc.
- Should have proof of good academic results (secondary).
- Should submit a one-page motivational letter demonstrating why the individual is a good candidate to receive a bursary. The letter should also include all the required information as per application form.

Internal Process

Once you have applied and submitted all the required documents (as per the application form) before the deadline, 31 August annually, an internal & external panel evaluates each application. Applicants are shortlisted and thereafter interviews are conducted to ensure that we award bursaries to the most appropriate students, who will ultimately become NFVF Ambassadors.

Important Factors

- Please ensure that all details on the application form are correct.
- If telephone numbers or addresses change, notify us immediately. If we are unable to contact you, the bursary will be awarded to another deserving student.
- Please ensure that all the required information is submitted to avoid the disqualification of your application.
- First year students receive 100% towards tuition fee only, thereafter we pay 80% towards tuition fee only. The rationale behind this is the result of minimal resources at our disposal as we endeavour to find a balance between the number of students we support & how much we contribute towards those bursaries.

International Bursaries

Individuals may apply to the NFVF for bursaries to support their studies at international tertiary institutions for film courses that are not available in South Africa. Due to minimal resources at the NFVF's disposal, 100% bursaries will not be awarded.

Supporting Documents

The following supporting documentation must be submitted together with an official application form:

- A covering letter including personal motivation for study and its relevance to the applicant's intended career path, as well as how the skills acquired will benefit South Africa.
- A letter of support from the international institution.
- Proof of excellence within the applicant's field of competency.
